

Medicaid and CHIP Services for Incarcerated Youth



The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 included new requirements for Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) agencies to cover certain medical, behavioral health, dental screening and diagnostic services, and case management services for incarcerated youth to support successful reentry from secure juvenile detentions facilities, local jails, and state prisons.

At minimum, states must provide the screening and diagnostic services in accordance with Early Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment (EPSDT) standards for those under the age of 21 eligible for Medicaid. **States must also provide**Targeted Case Management (TCM) services 30 days prior to release and for at least 30 days post-release, including:



Assessment of need for medical, educational, social, and other services



Development of and updates to an individualized, person-centered care plan



Referral and service linkage to services and supports for behavioral health, health-related social needs, and other needs as identified in care plan



Ongoing monitoring and follow-up activities
