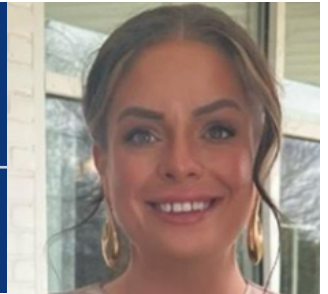


Dr. Mauria Uhlik
