He later became a literacy specialist for the Florida Department of Education, where he provided professional development for reading teachers in low-performing schools across the state. Paul also directed the nationally recognized 5000 Role Models of Excellence Project, a dropout prevention initiative serving more than 8,000 at-risk minority males across Miami-Dade County schools. His leadership extended beyond the classroom as he guided crisis response efforts for hundreds of schools and supported professional learning for school leaders. In addition, Paul has served as a Governor-appointed member and Education Subcommittee Chair of the Florida Council on the Social Status of Black Men and Boys, helping to shape policy and advance equity, access, and opportunity statewide. These experiences laid the foundation for his role at PCG, where he continues to bridge leadership, curriculum, and student-focused solutions for districts nationwide.
