As Deputy Director of the Bureau of Fiscal Management, Mr. Albertoni supervised the development of Managed Care Organization (MCO) capitation rates and incentive payments developed to promote plan adherence to performance benchmarks and managed implementation of statewide hospital assessment. He helped implement a preferred drug list and a benchmark plan that was adopted with the implementation of BadgerCare Plus in 2008.
